Goal 3. Ensure healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages.

By 2030 reduce the global maternal mortality ratio to less than 70 per 100,000 live births

b. Provide nutrition training to the mother's clubs members.

3,000 rural women have received nutrition training.

7,500 women will receive nutrition training.

c. Arrange cooking demonstrations sessions to teach how to prepare nutritious meal for children and family members

3,000 rural women participated in cooking demonstration sessions.

7,500 women will participate in cooking demonstration sessions.

By 2030 end preventable deaths of newborns and under-five children

a. IFB offers all pregnant mothers regular physical check-up, basic pathological test of blood/urine and ultra-sonogram at IFB hospitals. They also receive vaccination, folic acid, vitamin A, iron and calcium.

a. 9,986 women received AN/PN care and 7,438 women got folic acid, vitamin supplements and iron.

16,000 women will receive AN/PN care and 4,500 women will get folic acid, iron and vitamin supplements.

b. 154 pregnant women gave birth to their children at IFB's Chuadanga hospital.

IFB will establish separate gynea units at Chuadanga and Meherpur hospitals.

b. Provide 7-days basic training to traditional birth attendants with delivery kit to ensure safe delivery.

1,307 TBAs received basic training with delivery kits.

3,500 TBAs will get this training along with delivery kits.

a. Provide healthcare service to children through IFB hospitals and satellite clinics.

8,567 children under 5 received various healthcare services, 225 children of disabling condition and 180 received serial plaster to treat their club foot.

22,250 children will receive treatment and/or surgery.

b. Immunize and distribute vitamin A to the children.

5,466 children got immunization and vitamin A.

14,000 children will have received Vitamin-A and immunization.

By 2030 end the epidemics of AIDS, tuberculosis, malaria, and neglected tropical diseases and combat hepatitis, water-borne diseases, and other communicable diseases

Provide immunization for prevention of communicable disease among children and women including rubella vaccination among adolescent/young girls and women.

5,466 children received EPI vaccination and 80 adolescent/youth girls/women received rubella vaccine.

14,000 children will get EPI vaccination and 200 will get this vaccine.

By 2030 ensure universal access to sexual and reproductive health care services, including for family planning, information and education, and the integration of reproductive health into national strategies and programmed

Conduct health education session at the mother's club and hospital's premises for patients and their accompanying persons.

Total 1,20,582 received health education to upgrade their knowledge.

2,35,000 will receive health education.

Achieve universal health coverage (UHC), including financial risk protection, access to quality essential health care services, and access to safe, effective, quality, and affordable essential medicines and vaccines for all

Provide treatment of eye, ENT, orthopedic, cleft lip and palate at IFB hospitals. Also, mobile van with a medical team goes out to remote areas to provide health care especially women, children and old people.

1,86,371 patients were received treatment at OPD, satellite clinics and Mobile van.

4,75,000 patients will receive treatment.

By 2030 substantially reduce the number of deaths and illnesses from hazardous chemicals and air, water, and soil pollution and contamination

Install arsenic removal plant and ring-well to ensure arsenic free drinking water for the rural communities in Chuadanga and Meherpur district.

6 ARP-SIDKO plant installed in 4 upzillas in Chuadanga district and Meherpur districts.

10 ARP SIDKO plants will install.

Increase substantially health financing and the recruitment, development and training and retention of the health workforce in developing countries, especially in LDCs and SIDS

IFB conducts training on 'Identification of Disability' for different workforce in the community such as school teachers, community leaders and NGO health workers so that they can identify disability and make mass awareness to prevent disability.

2,091 school teachers, community leaders and NGO health workers received in training.

6,000 school teachers, community leaders and NGO health workers will receive this training.
